

# \#LOVEF2S People's Trophies Driver Information - v1.0-SKEGNESS 

## Introduction

- Thank you for taking part in the \#lovef2s People's Trophies.
- The meetings are uniquely funded with the majority of money coming from race fans, teams, and sponsors through a JustGiving crowd-funding initiative.
- Please support the sponsors who have funded these events.


## Prize-Fund

- The winner of each event will receive $£ \mathbf{1 , 5 0 0}$.
- The top-10 prize-money will be as follows:

- ALL other drivers qualifying for the Feature-Final, and taking the green flag, will receive $£ 50$.
- Heat winners will receive a $£ 100$ bonus.
- Any driver not making the Feature-Final will be rewarded with $£ 10$ appearance money.
- The best finisher in each grade (W, Y, B, and R/SS), not in the top-3 podium places in the FeatureFinal, will receive a $£ 100$ bonus.
- The best finisher in each grade (W, Y, B, and R/SS), not in the top-3 podium places in the FeatureFinal, will receive a $£ 25$ McGill Motorsport voucher, except whichever grade finishes in $4^{\text {th }}$ place they will receive a HiFly tyre instead, courtesy of WRC Fabrications and MW Fabrications.


## Scrutineering

- Cars MUST be safety-checked pre-meeting by the local team, as normal.
- Additional scrutineers will also be in attendance to look at technical items.
- Due to the prize-funding involved, some significant post-race technical checks will be required.
- These will be coordinated by the BriSCA F2 team.
- Trophies and other awards presented at the conclusion of the race MUST be returned to officials until such time as post-race checks have been completed successfully.


## Driver Briefing and Info

- F2 practice FINISHES at 5pm
- A driver briefing will be held, prior to the start of the meeting, in the following location:
- Skegness - In/by the scrutineering shed, at 5:10pm
- Additional information will be posted on the pits noticeboard in the usual location (Heat splits, Consolation allocations, Feature-Final qualifications, etc.). Please keep an eye on this.


## Meeting Format

- You will each compete in one Heat, with your finishing position determining whether you progress straight to the People's Trophy Feature-Final, or have to take part in one or more Consolations.
- The better you do in your Heat, the easier your run to the big-money race.
- Unlike a normal meeting, the higher you finish in your Heat, the better your grid position in the Feature-Final.
- Heat winners will start at the front of your grade in the Feature-Final.
- Drivers failing to qualify for the Feature-Final from the Heats will have to compete in one or more Consolations.
- There will be 2 Heats and 2 Consolations (a B-Consolation, followed by an A-Consolation).
- In summary:
- The top 12 in each Heat go straight to the Feature-Final
- The next 7 in each Heat go to the A-Consolation (run before the Feature-Final)
- 11 drivers will qualify for the Feature-Final from the A-Consolation
- The remainder are done for the big money unfortunately
- The remaining drivers in each Heat go to the B-Consolation (run before the A-Consolation)
- The winner of the B-Consolation goes straight to the Feature-Final
- The next 10 drivers will go to the A-Consolation to continue their quest to qualify for the Feature-Final
- The remainder are done for the big money unfortunately
- The order of the races on the day is therefore:
- Heats -> B-Consolation -> A-Consolation -> Feature-Final


## Heats

- There will be 2 Heats with the drivers currently booked in, split as equally as possible.
- Heat allocations will be made prior to the meeting; however, the order in which the Heats are run will be determined by a random public draw prior to the commencement of the meeting for fairness.
- Heats will run over 16 laps.
- Heats will run in normal graded order.
- Positions within grades will simply be the order in which drivers enter the track.
- The finishing order is important right through the field, as this will determine grid positions in the

Feature-Final, or which Consolation(s) you must race in.

- Heat winners will receive a trophy on track.


## Consolations

- There will be 2 Consolations... the B-Consolation, followed by the A-Consolation.
- There will be up to 17 cars in the B-Consolation (based on 55 booked cars currently) fighting for 1 guaranteed starting spot in the Feature-Final, and a further 10 spots in the A-Consolation.
- There will be 24 cars in the A-Consolation, fighting for 11 spots in the Feature-Final
- The B-Consolation will run as a 10-lap dash.
- The A-Consolation will run over 16 laps.
- Consolations will run in normal graded order.
- Positions within grades will simply be the order in which drivers enter the track.
- The finishing order is important, as this will determine grid positions in the Feature-Final, or if you must run a second Consolation in order to try and qualify.
- Consolation winners will receive a trophy on track.


## People's Trophies Feature-Final

- There will be 36 cars in the People's Trophy Feature-Final.
- The Feature-Final will be lined up in a gridded order, within grades, so please line up as directed by track staff.
- Once you have taken your correct place on the grid you should turn off your engine to await the command to fire up.
- The Feature-Final will run over 23 laps
- The Feature-Final will see UP TO 5-rolling laps being completed, with the green flag being shown at a time of the starter's choosing. This is an attempt to prevent any jumped starts.
- You MUST maintain a steady slow rolling-lap speed, with the appropriate gaps between grades... INCLUDING Superstars to Reds.
- You WILL be docked places if you jump the start, or fail to maintain grade gaps.
- If a yellow-flag occurs within the first lap after the initial start, then a complete restart will be ordered.
- You will NOT be allowed to work on your car with ANY tools, or spares from within your car, from another car, within the confines of the racetrack, or passed over the fence.
- Outside assistance will NOT be permitted. (An action by a race official for safety reasons is NOT considered outside assistance).
- You WILL be able to exit your car under supervision, in a safe location, and make a quick repair using your hands ONLY, e.g. bending a bumper hoop off a tyre, putting a coil-over spring cap back in to place, or bending a damaged body-panel back in to shape.
- Only ONE complete restart will be attempted, unless exceptional circumstances require a further one.
- Subsequent yellow flags will result in a race-suspension and follow normal single-file restart procedures.
- The winning driver ONLY may be permitted to perform celebratory "donuts" in a safe location as per the tracks' own risk assessments TO BE CONFIRMED at the Driver's Briefing: Other drivers should be aware of this and leave the area clear.
- The following drivers/positions will be required to the start-line at the end of the race. Directions will be given over the race receivers, or via track staff:
- Top 3 finishers
- Highest White-top, not in the top3 *
- Highest Yellow-top, not in the top3 *
- Highest Blue-top, not in the top3 *
- Highest Red-top/Superstar, not in the top3 *
(* Logically, one of these will be in $4^{\text {th }}$ place)
- On completion of the trophy presentations, interviews and photo calls in Victory Lane, and a lap of honour round the track, the trophies and tyres MUST be returned to officials until such time as the post-race technical checks have been completed.
- The top 4 cars MUST remain at the track following the Feature-Final, where engine and other technical checks will take place.
- Prize-monies for the top 4 drivers will NOT be paid out until the successful completion of technical checks has been confirmed by the scrutineering team.


## Driver Pay-Out

- EVERY driver racing in the meetings WILL receive some prize-money pay-out.
- Driver pay-out will be conducted as normal:
- Skegness Both days of the speed-weekend, in the bar, at the conclusion of the meeting.
- You or your representative MUST present your race licence when collecting prize-money.
- A signature will be required to confirm receipt of prize/appearance money.
